3. NLSIU charges Room Rent Rs 125 per day for accommodation at the hostels. A Resident is provided with a cot, bed and one pillow. Rooms are allotted on triple sharing basis.

6. NLSIU shall bear no responsibility for the personal belongings of the Residents

The charges for use of Mess facility is based on actual and the same shall be remitted by the Residents before they leave the campus.
