About the Project under CWL

Title: Reintegration and rehabilitation of acid attack victims

Objectives and scope of study

The study has the following major objectives

1. To study the legal and policy framework relating to acid attack victims in India
2. To examine how this works on the ground
3. To identify gaps in this framework using examples from other countries or good practices in India
4. Suggesting ways and means in which rehabilitation and reintegration of acid attack victims can be done in a meaningful way. (including disability quota)

The work includes research and carrying out field work, providing research support to the Coordinator, working with students and performing other tasks to ensure that project deadlines are met efficiently.

The maximum amount payable will be a consolidated amount of Rs. 25,000 per month.
