ADMISSION TO LL.M. PROGRAMME

FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-25 AGAINST THE FIFTH ALLOTMENT LIST

The Fifth List of selected candidates for NLSIU to be notified by CLAT 2024 will be provisionally admitted to the LL.M. Programme for the A.Y. 2024-25.

Document verification and associated processes related to provisional admission shall be carried out between **May 29, 2024 and May 30, 2024**.

The selected candidates are hereby required to carefully complete the admission formalities set out below.

Step 1: Fill and submit the Admission Form along with the necessary supporting documents

Once the Fifth Allotment List has been published by the CLAT Consortium, login credentials for the **NLSIU Admission Portal** shall be communicated to the registered Email ID of the selected candidate as provided in the CLAT portal by **4 p.m on May 28, 2024**.

The selected candidates are required to fill in the admission form and upload the scanned copies of the following documents on the **NLSIU Student Portal** by **2 p.m. on May 29, 2024**.

Documents to be submitted immediately

1. Class X Certificate
2. Class XII Certificate
3. LLB Degree Certificate or a Declaration in Lieu of It*
4. Recent passport size colour photo
5. Caste certificate, if applicable.
6. EWS certificate, if applicable.
7. Disability Certificate, if applicable.
8. Documents relating to qualifying for Karnataka category, if applicable.
9. Any one of the following Government issued Identity Card:
 - a) Driver's License, b) Aadhaar Card, c) Passport, d) Voter ID or e) Ration Card

**Candidates who are yet to write their LL.B. Examination or have not received their marksheet shall submit a Declaration to the effect that the LLB Examination Marksheet and Certificate shall be submitted on or before September 30, 2024 and that admission will remain provisional until the submission of the certificate and the marksheet indicating that the candidate has met the eligibility criteria. [See Annexure-I]*

Please note that only the following authorities are competent to issue Caste Certificates, OBC-Non-Creamy Layer Certificates and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Certificates:

- District Magistrate/ Additional Magistrate/ Collector/ Deputy Commissioner/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/ Deputy Collector/ Ist Class Stipendiary Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate/ Taluka Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Commissioner (not below the rank of Ist Class Stipendiary Magistrate).
- Chief Presidency Magistrate / Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate / Presidency Magistrate.
- Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and
- Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his family resides.

For Karnataka Students Category seats, only study certificates issued by duly recognised and affiliated Schools, which attest that the candidate has completed at least 10 years of schooling in Karnataka, shall be accepted.

The OBC-Non Creamy Layer Certificates and EWS Certificate must not be older than a year.

Step 2: Interview with Academic Administration Staff

An interview slot shall be notified to each selected candidate by email for online document verification. The interview slots shall be scheduled on: May 29, at 4 pm.

The candidates shall be required to join the Zoom meeting room at the notified slot. They must keep the original copies of the submitted documents with them at the time of the interview.

Step 3: Communication of Acceptance of Documents to Candidate

If all the documents uploaded are found to be in order, the University shall send to the candidate an emailed communication of acceptance of documents.

Step 4: Fee Payment

To secure their seat, the candidate has to pay the Adjusted University Fees, as defined below:

Adjusted University Fees shall mean the **University Fee, after adjusting for Confirmation Fee and Counselling Registration Fee and any fee paid to the previously allotted NLU as part of any previous round of counselling.**

The Adjusted University Fee for the respective student shall be uploaded as an invoice request on **the NLSIU Student Portal** after verification of documents and communication of Acceptance of Documents to Candidate.

The fee may be remitted through the payment gateway provided in the NLSIU Student Portal via any of the following instruments.

- **Credit Card**
- **Debit Card**
- **Net Banking Options**
- **Demand Draft**
- **RTGS**

All candidates who have chosen the Freeze or Float Option in the counselling process in the Fifth Round of Counselling are required to make the Payment of Adjusted University Fee **on or before 1 p.m on June 10, 2024.**

The details of the **Financial Aid Policy and Financial Aid Application Forms** will be available on the NLSIU Student Portal.

Candidates allotted to NLSIU in Fifth Allotment List who are desirous of financial aid in terms of the NLSIU Financial Aid Policy are **required to submit their application on or before May 30, 2024, 11.59 p.m.**

Please note that candidates are required to pay the full Adjusted University Fee by 1 p.m., June 10, 2024, even if they seek to apply for financial aid. In case, their application for financial aid is approved, the amount for which financial aid has been granted shall be reimbursed.

The University shall communicate its decision on the financial aid application form around July 15, 2024.

Step 5 - Original Document Verification, Admission, Orientation Programme and Commencement of Classes

The verification of original certificates and all admission-related processes shall be completed in person on June 29, 2024. All candidates are required to report to the campus on June 29, 2024. The Orientation Programme shall commence on July 1, 2024.

General Information

- Hostel accommodation or off-campus accommodation shall not be provided to the LLM Candidates admitted against the Fifth List.

- Admission for all candidates shall remain provisional until verification of original certificates and completion of admission-related processes on campus in June 2024.
