**September 18, 2022:** The 30th Annual Convocation of the National Law School of India University was held on Sunday, September 18, 2022. As the COVID pandemic impacted nearly every aspect of daily life and prevented large events/gatherings, the University was forced to conduct its Convocation virtually for two years in a row during 2020 and 2021.

This year, we are happy to have conducted our 30th Annual Convocation in the offline mode, at the Dr Babu Rajendra Prasad International Convention Centre, GKVK campus, Bengaluru.

NLSIU Vice-Chancellor, Prof (Dr.) Sudhir Krishnaswamy presented his Annual Report on the occasion and thanked the Chief Justice of India and Chancellor of the University, Hon'ble Justice U U Lalit, and the Chief Guest, Shri Nandan Niklekani for their time and effort to ensure a successful Convocation.

## **Graduates:**

This year, 829 students graduated from the various academic programmes of NLSIU. This includes:

- 6 from the Ph.D Programme
- 1 from the Master of Philosophy Programme
- 53 from the Master of Public Policy Programme
- 40 from the Master of Laws Programme
- 76 from the Bachelor of Arts and Laws (Honours) Programme and

 653 students from the Online & Hybrid Education Programmes - this includes the Master of Business Laws Degree and seven other Postgraduate Diploma programmes.

## **Medals & Prizes:**

The University awarded a total of 48 gold medals to graduates during the convocation. The medals were awarded to 13 BA LLB (Hons) graduates, seven LLM graduates, two MPP graduates and one MBL gold medal to a candidate from the Online & Hybrid Education programmes.

Saurabh Gupta received 8 gold medals, followed by Vrishank Singhania and Pallavi Khatri, who received 7 and 6 gold medals respectively. All three students graduated from the B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) programme of the University.
