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Notice Inviting Quotations

The National Law School of India, Bangalore ("NLSIU") is a university established under the National Law School of India Act, 1986, imparting legal education. Email quotations for "**Fabrication and Installation of the External Gates**" are hereby invited from eligible contractors by the undersigned, subject to the terms and conditions enumerated hereunder.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The intending Bidders shall submit the quotes for the enclosed Scope of work and reference drawings (**Annexure 1**).
2. A consolidated amount (inclusive of taxes and all other charges) is to be submitted in the form of email quotation to NLSIU. Hard copies of the quotations will be accepted up to 5.00 PM on 29.02.2024. You need to send the hard copy addressed to Finance Officer, National Law School of India University, Nagarbhavi, Bangalore-560072.
3. Interested Bidders must make a visit to the site and take a detailed survey of the requirements mentioned and submit the quote accordingly.
4. You need to prepare the shop drawings for approval from the University for each gate.
5. You need take permission before discarding any of the material from the campus.
6. You need to review and confirm if gate automation can also be integrated and share the cost of the same separately.
7. You need to share cost and timeline per gate.
8. You need to provide the barricade to keep the campus safe and secure during the time of construction.
9. Rates quoted by the bidders shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes, including GST. Income Tax and all other statutory deductions like labour cess etc. will be deducted from the payments made as per prevailing rules.

10. GST Registration number and PAN number of the Bidder shall be mentioned in the quotation.
11. The Bidder should provide a Defect Liability Period (DLP) of minimum 2 year for the work carried out at the Site.
12. The Rate quoted shall be firm and fixed till completion of the entire work & shall not attract any escalation under any circumstances whatsoever.
13. The University shall not bind itself to accept the lowest quoted rate. The University shall accept the quotation that is in best interests of the University, as determined by the University authorities. The University reserves the right to not accept any of the Quotations submitted during this process.
14. The University shall issue a work order ("Work Order") to the successful Bidder ("Selected Bidder") within 30 days of opening of the quotations. The Work Order shall consist of terms and conditions, Bill of quantities and drawings (**Annexures 1**). Acceptance of the Work Order by the Selected Bidder shall form a binding contract with the University.
15. Date of start of work shall be reckoned from the date of the issue of the Work Order.
16. Payment terms for the work shall be as per the following milestones –
- a. 25% of the value will be paid as advance.
 - b. 25% for Fabrication.
 - c. Balance will be paid after the installation and completion.
19. Any damage to NLSIU property will be made good at Selected Bidder's risk and cost.
20. NLSIU will not be held responsible for payment of any compensation to the labourers engaged by Selected Bidder. Selected Bidder will pay all compensations including accident compensations due to its labourers.
21. Selected Bidders shall follow all safety rules and security procedures that are in force and applicable during execution of work.
22. Selected Bidders shall comply with applicable provisions of all acts, statutes, rules and regulations of Central and State Governments, as the case may be.
23. Retention Amount at the rate of 5% of the value of the work done for each running account bill will be deducted. The Retention amount will be released to the Selected Bidder after completion of the defect's liability period of 365 days. The retention amount shall not bear any interest whatsoever. Water and electricity will be provided by the University at the site. The cost of electricity consumed by Selected Bidder will be recovered from the Selected Bidder at the rate of 1% of the chargeable amounts for the tasks that require electricity. For any reason, if electricity is not provided by the University, the Selected Bidder shall make arrangements to continue the work without any disruption.
24. The Work must be carried out within the stipulated completion period, with all due diligence, failing which, Selected Bidder shall be liable to pay a Penalty for Delay of an amount equal to 0.2% of the Contract Value per day of delay. The

1	Demolition of existing columns to support the current gate. All the debris to be carted away from the site.	As per site measurement
2	Removal of existing gate. Existing MS gate to be handed over to NLSIU.	
3	Excavation and construction to lay the foundation for the MS columns. Contractor to share the foundation details.	As per shop drawing to be shared by contractor.
4	Levelling the site post works and redoing the ground patch if required.	
5	Structural steel works for Columns finished with duco paint	As per shop drawing to be shared by contractor.
6	Fabricating and fixing gate made of MS Pipe, MS square bars/tube, MS flats, MS shoes welded as per design.	As per shop drawing to be shared by contractor.
7	Providing and fixing locking system for the gate.	As per shop drawing to be shared by contractor.
8	Providing and applying Duco paint on all members including primer and base preparation all complete.
