

Dr. Sneha Thapliyal is a trained environmental economist. A Ph.D. in Public Policy from the Indian Institute of Management,

Bangalore, she also was a Canadian Commonwealth Scholar at McGill University, Canada (2013). She is also associated with IIM, Indore as an associate professor. Her primary research interests are biodiversity conservation, environmental governance, policy analyses, inequalities, and pedagogy. At NLSIU, she takes courses on microeconomics, environmental economics, and responsible business for MPP students.

2. **Dr. Sony Pellissery**

Dr. Sony Pellissery is a Ph.D. from Oxford University and winner of the India Social Science Research award (2009). and Ram Reddy Memorial Award for Social Science (2015).

He is a public policy specialist with a special interest in distributive justice and has been at the centre of teaching core public policy courses to MPP students.

3. **Dr. Babu Mathew**

Professor



Prof. Babu Mathew is a central figure in the Trade Union movement and various other social movements taking up issues of bonded labour, child labour, displacement, and destruction of the

livelihoods destruction of the livelihoods of the marginalized. Combined with the teaching and practice of Human Rights during the last six years, he has also served as Country Director of Action Aid International in India. He led the process of presenting a Shadow Report focusing on the excluded communities of India before the relevant UN Committee in Geneva. For MPP he has been at the helm of supervising and teaching development, law, and policy courses for the MPP cohorts.

4. **Srijoni Sen** Professor



After graduating from NLSIU in 2009, Srijoni Sen began her career at McKinsey & Co. as a Business Analyst before completing a Master's degree in Law at Columbia University, where she also studied at the School of International and Public Affairs (SIPA). She was subsequently a founding team member of the Vidhi Centre for Legal Policy where she led the Public Law team and ran an open resource digitizing explaining Indian laws. She has been a central figure in teaching courses on regulatory governance and legal aspects, contract management, and negotiations to the MPP students.

5. **Dr. Sudipa Sarkar** Assistant Professor



Dr. Sudipa Sarkar received Marie Curie's Ph.D. Fellowship from the European Commission and completed her Ph.D. in 2017 at the Department of Applied Economics, University of Salamanca, Spain.


She has also been a visiting researcher at European Foundation for Living and Working Conditions (Eurofound), Dublin. She has experience working in several other research organizations and projects such as the Indian Statistical Institute, New Delhi, Institute of Rural Management Anand, and the Young Lives Project (led by Oxford University). Sudipa has been awarded Prof MJ Manohar Rao Award for the year 2019 from the Indian Econometric Society (TIES). She has worked on several research projects funded by the Economic and Social Research Council (ESRC), UK, European Commission, and United Nations University (UNU-WIDER), Helsinki. Sudipa served as a member of Oxfam Great Britain's Policy Advisory Group from 2018 to 2021. At NLS, she is an assistant professor of economics and teaches development economics, statistics, and econometrics to the graduating batch of MPP.



6. **Dr. Anup Pujari** Visiting Faculty


