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## **NOTIFICATION**

### **ADMISSION TO LL.M. PROGRAMME**

### **FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26 AGAINST THE FIRST ALLOTMENT LIST**

The First List of selected candidates for NLSIU to be notified by CLAT 2025 will be provisionally admitted to the LL.M. Programme for the A.Y. 2025-26.

Document verification and associated processes related to provisional admission shall be carried out between **June 17, 2025 and June 19, 2025**

The selected candidates are hereby required to carefully complete the admission formalities set out below.

#### **Step 1: Fill and submit the Admission Form along with the necessary supporting documents**

Once the First Allotment List has been published by the CLAT Consortium, the admission form for uploading documents shall be shared with the selected candidates via their registered Email IDs as provided by the CLAT consortium by **1400 hours on June 17, 2025**.

The selected candidates are required to fill in the admission form and upload copies of the following documents by **1400 hours on June 18, 2025**.

#### **Documents to be submitted immediately**

1. Class X Certificate
2. Class XII Certificate
3. LLB Degree Certificate and Marksheet or a Declaration in Lieu of It\*
4. Recent passport size colour photo
5. Caste certificate, if applicable.
6. EWS certificate, if applicable.
7. Disability Certificate, if applicable.
8. Documents relating to qualifying for Karnataka category, if applicable.
9. Any one of the following Government issued Identity Card:
  - a) Driver's License, b) Aadhaar Card, c) Passport, d) Voter ID, e) PAN Card, or f) Ration Card

***\*Candidates who are yet to receive their Degree Certificate or Marksheet shall submit a Declaration to the effect that the LLB Examination Marksheet and Certificate shall be submitted on or before September 30, 2025 and that admission will remain provisional until the submission of the certificate and the marksheet indicating that the candidate has met the eligibility criteria. [See Annexure-I]***

Please note that only the following authorities are competent to issue Caste Certificates, OBC-Non-Creamy Layer Certificates and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Certificates:

- District Magistrate/ Additional Magistrate/ Collector/ Deputy Commissioner/ Additional Deputy Commissioner/ Deputy Collector/ Ist Class Stipendiary Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional magistrate/ Taluka Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Commissioner (not below the rank of Ist Class Stipendiary Magistrate).
- Chief Presidency Magistrate / Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate / Presidency Magistrate.
- Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar and
- Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his family resides

For Karnataka Students Category seats, only study certificates issued by duly recognised and affiliated educational institutions, which attest that the candidate has completed at least 10 years of education in Karnataka, shall be accepted.

The OBC-Non Creamy Layer Certificates and EWS Certificate must not be older than a year.

## **Step 2: Interview with Academic Administration Staff**

An interview slot shall be notified to each selected candidate by email for online document verification. The interview slots shall be scheduled on 18 and 19 June 2025. On June 18, interviews shall be scheduled between 2:00 - 5:00 pm, and on June 19, interviews shall be scheduled between 11:00 am - 1:00 pm and 2:00 pm - 3:00 pm.

The candidates are required to join the Microsoft Teams meeting room at the notified slot. Candidates should ensure that they join the meeting at the designated time and have the original copies of all documents submitted ready for verification. While the verification itself may take no



more than five minutes, they may need to remain available online for the entire duration of the assigned time slot.

### **Step 3: Communication of Acceptance of Documents to Candidate**

If all the documents uploaded are found to be in order, the University shall send to the candidate an email communication on acceptance of documents.

### **Step 4: Payment of Confirmation Fee to CLAT Consortium**

Candidates must pay the Confirmation Fee as per the instructions of the CLAT Consortium within the stipulated time in the Admissions Counselling Calendar released by the CLAT Consortium - on or before 1300 hours on June 19, 2025.

### **Step 5: Fee Payment**

**The payment of the University Fee shall commence on June 21, 2025. All candidates who have been admitted during the counselling process must pay the University Fee on or before June 28, 2025, 5 p.m., regardless of whether they have applied for financial aid or not.** Failure to pay the fees by the due date (i.e., June 28, 2025) will result in the cancellation of provisional admission.

The **University Fee amount**, after adjusting for the Confirmation Fee and Counselling Registration Fee, for candidates who select the Freeze Option in the counselling process is as follows:

The details of the **Fee structure, Financial Aid Policy, and Financial Aid Application Forms** shall also be emailed to the candidates.

The fee may be remitted through the payment gateway that will be emailed to the candidates after provisional acceptance of documents.

### **Applying for Financial Aid**

Candidates who select the Freeze Option and wish to apply for financial assistance under the University's Financial Aid Policy are required to submit their application **on or before June 27, 2025, 11:59 pm**. However, before submitting their application for University's financial aid, they **must** apply under the PM Vidyalaxmi Scheme.

NLSIU has been recognised by the Government of India under the PM-Vidyalaxmi Scheme as one of the leading higher educational institutions in the country and students of NLSIU are eligible for applying under this scheme.

The PM Vidyalaxmi Scheme provides collateral-free and guarantor-free education loans to meritorious students. There is no income limit to apply for this scheme, and loans up to INR 30 lakhs can be availed. Partial and full interest subvention is available for lower annual family incomes. ### **Decision on Financial Aid Application**

The University will communicate its decision on the financial aid applications by July 31, 2025. Students who are provided financial aid shall have their fee reimbursed up to the extent of the aid provided.

### **Step 6: Original Document Verification, Admission, Orientation Programme and Commencement of Classes**

The verification of original certificates and completion of admission-related processes shall be conducted on June 29, 2025. All candidates are required to report to the NLSIU Campus in Bengaluru with at least one of their parents on the day. Orientation programme shall commence on June 30, 2025. The exact schedule shall be notified in due course.

### **General Information**

- All students admitted into the LLM programme shall be provided with off-campus accommodation.
